BECOME AN EARLY CHILDHOOD ASSISTANT

As an Early Childhood Assistant, you help to enhance children's self-esteem during daily activities and encourage the socialization of children as they play and experience things together. Early Childhood Assistants plan and aide with meal time, supervise children at playtime and during rest periods. Early Childhood Assistants also lead children in activities through stories and songs, preparing craft material, preparing and serving snacks, and guiding and assisting children in the development of proper hygiene habits. Early Childhood Assistants attend staff meetings to discuss progress and problems with children and they help the supervisor in keeping records, maintaining day care equipment and with housekeeping duties.

BEGIN A REWARDING CAREER WORKING WITH CHILDREN

Upon graduation from the Early Childhood Assistant program, you may find employment as assistant teachers in child care centres and nursery schools, or as family-home child care providers. Job titles include: Childcare Assistant, Childcare Worker, Daycare Early Childhood Educator Assistant, Day Care Worker, Day Care Teacher, Preschool Teacher, Baby Care Worker, Infant Day Care Worker, Nursery School Helper, Preschool Helper.
